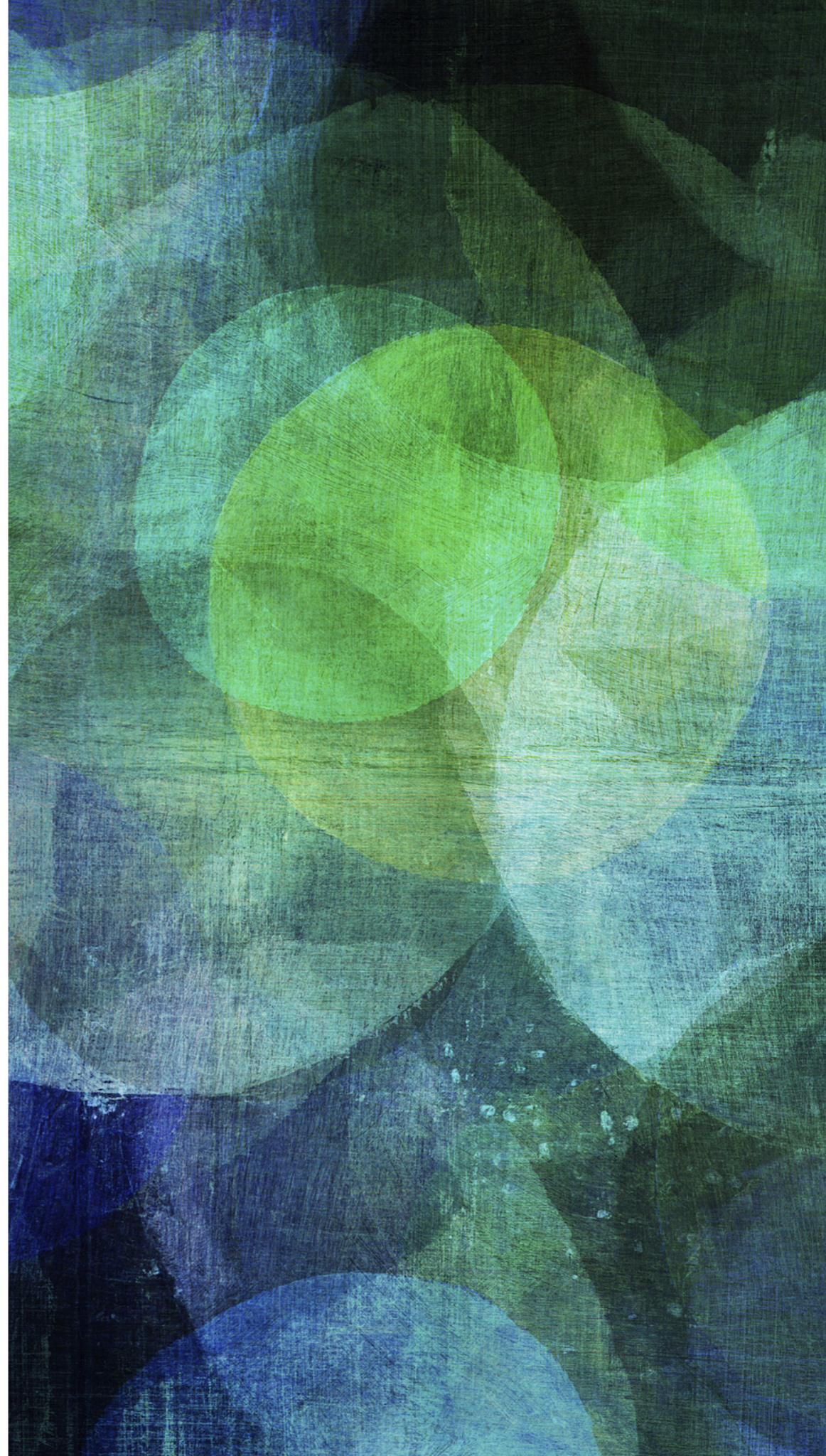

SECTION ONE: THE SACRIS IN PUBLIC

- Sacris visiting the community are sought for their wisdom in decision making or settling disputes.
- They are mindful of our balance with nature and exhibit non-ego based action.
- Sacris can be seen caring for others and protecting wildlife often with natural healing remedies.



SECTION TWO: CLOTHING

- Robes in 6 different colours that define member roles.
- In order from left to right are: Light, Earth, Fire, Wind, Water and Shadow.



SECTION TWO: SYMBOLISM

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- The tree of life is seen as having a affiliation between the planet elements, and could be a illustration of the infinite connection of all things and creation.
- In Chinese philosophy, yin and yang describe how seemingly opposite or contrary forces may very well be complementary, interconnected and independent within the nature.
- These 2 sides blended together as our factions symbol supports our principles and spiritual teachings.

SECTION THREE: HOW WE LIVE

- The life and customs of Sacris consist of a spiritual meaning and live apart from society in a community temple, usually in high elevated areas overlooking cities or seas.
- Their daily life follows an strict schedule that revolves around meditation, spiritual study, and taking part in aid work within the community and environment.
- In their free time, they enjoy in nature, assisting others or enjoying personal freedoms.



SECTION THREE: ROLES

- Sacris are equal to all members, there is no hierarchy of power or control - they share all responsibilities as a whole. Your soul is your innermost being, your higher self, who you really are, According to Sacris teachings, a member's soul will have one of six distinct 'vibrations or tones'.

- Fire; fire souls are naturally forceful, loyal protective, determined, steadfast.

- Wind; wind souls are naturally creative, inventive, imaginative, playful, decorative.

- Water; water souls are naturally engaging, articulate, charming, entertaining, expressive.

- Shadow; shadow souls are naturally curious, studious, academic, analytical, neutral.



SECTION THREE: ROLES IN ACTION

- Light & Earth are both **inspiration** specialists, concerned with the well-being of others, serving greater good, seeking to improve the quality of life for all.
- Water & Wind are both **expression** specialists, concerned with bring ideas to life, giving form or voice to their inner thoughts and feelings, thereby changing other's perceptions.
- Fire are **action** specialists, concerned with turning practical objectives into reality, making things happen, setting goals and moving towards them.
- Shadows are the caretakers of our spiritual learning and ate teachers to new members while they train.

SECTION FOUR: SKILLS, UNDERSTANDING AND KNOWLEDGE ON THE ENVIRONMENT

Develop skilful means:

- Cultivating mindfulness - practicing awareness builds resilience in w world of challenges.
- Non ego-based action - reducing self interest results in stronger shared outcomes.
- Practice equanimity - stability and calmness increase the possibility for insight and kindness.

Follow ethical guidelines:

- Non harming - ecological, economic, ethical sustainability for the long term is the sum of the efforts.
- Practicing restraint - self awareness of desire and the practice of restraint can be personally and socially transformative, a foundation for ethical behaviour.
- Caring for others as self - ethical people create an ethical society.
- Cultivating the deep view - observing time in order to practice shift in perception and understanding that the past is linked to the present.

Spiritual well-being:

- Right relationship with self and community.
- Right relationship with the natural world.
- Ethical clarity, capacity for restraint from harming.
- Tolerance, respect for others paths.

- Harming of others.
- Alcohol or drug use - mental impairment.
- Subjugation - taking of another's personal freedoms.
- Theft - including fraud.
- Lies - mis truths, gossips etc.
